

How to Get from DC to JFK

Vamoose Bus - www.vamoosebus.com - stops in Rosslyn (Metro accessible). It is about \$30 one way.

Vamoose drops off at Penn Station* in NYC (30th St and 7th Ave)

Then EITHER:

Take a cab to JFK for a flat fee of \$45 plus tolls.

OR

Take the shuttle - <http://www.nyairportservice.com> - this is \$15; check the schedule first for times. However, you will have to walk two blocks uptown on 7th Ave. and get onto another bus. This shuttle is direct to JFK. It is located officially across the street from the Pennsylvania Hotel.

OR

Take the subway - the A Train inside Penn Station toward Far Rockaway, NOT to downtown or Ozone Park or uptown to Inwood. Get off at the Howard Beach/JFK stop. Then take the JFK AirTrain that stops at all terminals. Cost is about \$8.00.

OR

Take the LIRR (Long Island Railroad) which leaves from Penn Station. Take it to Jamaica Station and then take the AirTrain to JFK. Cost \$10.

Allow plenty of time to get to JFK. Traffic, weather etc can all make the trip that much longer.

*This is also where AmTrak trains from DC Union Station to New York City stop.
